

To whom it may concern:

Real estate professionals, including REALTORS®, are an essential business which is permitted to remain open by subsection 31(1) of Schedule 2 of Ontario Regulation 82/20 (as amended by Ontario Regulation 278/21 filed April 15, 2021), the "Rules for Areas in Stage 1" Regulation.

The nature of a REALTOR®'s work may require the REALTOR® to leave his or her residence for various reasons, including but not limited to inspecting properties listed or to be listed for sale or lease, showing properties to clients, arranging for or carrying out inspections, photography or videography of a property, arranging for appropriate repairs to or preparation of a property for sale or lease. Such activities are contemplated by paragraph 1 of subsection 1(1) of Schedule 1 of Ontario Regulation 265/21, the Stay-At-Home Order made pursuant to the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, which permit an individual to leave their place of residence where that is necessary for: "working or volunteering where the nature of the work or volunteering requires the individual to leave their residence".

A REALTOR® may be engaged in work that has caused him or her to leave his or her residence because it is necessary for that work to be carried outside of his or her residence

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
